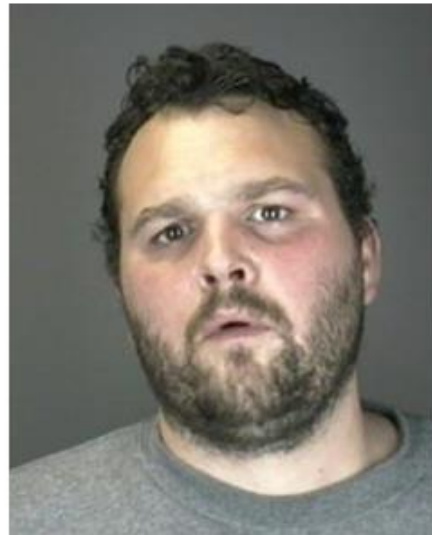

Murder Indictment in Colonie Homicide

ALBANY, NY – District Attorney P. David Soares announced today that **MICHAEL CHMIELEWSKI**, 23, and **SEAN MORELAND**, 32, both from Colonie, were each indicted by an Albany County Grand Jury for their alleged roles in the murder of Jacquelyn Porreca.

CHMIELEWSKI was indicted on (1) Count of Murder in the First Degree, a Class A-1 Felony, and (1) Count of Murder in the Second Degree, a Class A-I Felony, (1) Count of Robbery in the First Degree, a Class B Violent Felony, (1) Count of Burglary in the Second Degree, a Class C Violent Felony.

MORELAND was indicted on (1) Count of Murder in the Second Degree, a Class A-I Felony, (1) Count of Robbery in the First Degree, a Class B Violent Felony, (1) Count of Burglary in the Second Degree, a Class C Violent Felony, and (1) Count of Hindering Prosecution in the First Degree, a Class D Felony.

A Grand Jury returned an indictment alleging that on August 21, 2015, at approximately 3:35 P.M, in the area of 52 Sand Creek Road in the Town of Colonie, CHMIELEWSKI, while acting in concert with MORELAND, did allegedly illegally enter a place of business with the intent to commit a robbery, and while inside caused the death of Jacquelyn Porreca by means of stabbing her with a knife. Ms. Porreca did succumb to her injuries on August 23, 2015.

Additionally, the indictment alleges that MORELAND did provide transportation to CHMIELEWSKI while having reason to believe that CHMIELEWSKI had just committed a murder.

An arraignment date is pending and should be set by the court for sometime early next week.

Chief Assistant District Attorney David M. Rossi is handling the prosecution of this case.
