NYS Appellate Division Unanimously Upholds Conviction of Man Who Received Over 10 Lbs of Marijuana in the Mail



ALBANY, NY- District Attorney P. David Soares announced today that the New York Appellate Division, Third Department, upheld the conviction of ADAM VANVORST, who was

convicted in 2012 of possessing over ten pounds of marijuana that he received via the US mail. The decision can be found [here](#).

On November 30, 2012, VANVORST, then 40, was sentenced to 3 ½ years in State Prison followed by 2 years of Post Release Supervision before the Honorable Dan Lamont in Albany County Supreme Court.

On September 28, 2012, VANVORST was convicted after a jury trial of (1) Count of Criminal Possession of Marijuana in the First Degree, a Class C Felony before the Honorable Dan Lamont last night in Albany County Court.

On December 9, 2011, VANVORST was observed receiving and signing for a delivery package using a false name. The package contained several heat sealed clear bags of marijuana, which was later determined to be 12.25 pounds in weight.
