Sentencing for Attempted Cocaine Sale



ALBANY, NY - District Attorney P. David Soares announced today that RASHAD MAYE, 27, of Albany, was sentenced to 4 ½ years determinate in State Prison, to be followed by 3 years of Post-Release Supervision, before Honorable Judge Thomas A. Breslin in Albany County Court this morning.

On April 20, 2015, MAYE pleaded guilty to (1) Count of Attempted Criminal Sale of a Controlled Substance in the Third Degree, a Class C Felony.

An investigation by the Albany Police department uncovered that, during the evening of March 4, 2014, in the area of 220 Green Street, in the City of Albany, MAYE did knowingly and unlawfully sell a quantity of cocaine in exchange for a sum of US currency. MAYE's guilty plea today fully satisfies a total of (4) separate cocaine sales in the City of Albany.

Assistant District Attorney Joseph Brucato of the Street Crimes Unit prosecuted this case.
