Sentencing for Lark Street Robbery

ALBANY, NY – District Attorney P. David Soares announced today that OMAR ROGERS, 20, of Albany, and QURON TALLIE, 21, of Albany, each were sentenced to 5 years in State Prison, to be followed by 5 years Post Release Supervision, before the Honorable Thomas A. Breslin in Albany County Supreme Court this morning.

On May 25, 2016, ROGERS and TALLIE each pleaded guilty to (1) Count of Robbery in the Second Degree, a Class C Felony.

On May 6, 2016, at approximately 10:48 p.m., ROGERS and TALLIE, acting together, did forcibly enter a residence in the area of Lark Street in the City of Albany. While inside the residence ROGERS and TALLIE did forcibly steal two cell phones, cigarettes, and money from another individual. Albany City Police officers responded to the incident following a 911 call, and arrested ROGERS and TALLIE nearby the scene of the incident following a short foot chase. Following their arrest, ROGERS and TALLIE were each found to be in possession of one of the stolen cell phones.

Assistant District Attorney Joseph Brucato of the Street Crimes Unit handled the prosecution of this case.
