Sentencing for Repeat Burglar



ALBANY, NY - District Attorney P. David Soares announced today that **ANDREW GONZALEZ**, 26, of Albany, was sentenced to 13 years in State Prison before the Honorable Judge Roger D. McDonough in Albany County Supreme Court this morning. **GONZALEZ** was also ordered to pay restitution in the amount of \$10,155.91 USD to six different victims.

On separate dates in July 2014, **GONZALEZ** did unlawfully enter three residences in the City of Albany on Yates Street, Morris Street, and Myrtle Avenue. While inside these residences,

GONZALEZ did steal multiple items of property, including electronics, computers, jewelry, video game systems, and a camera. A search warrant of GONZALEZ's residence did uncover some of the stolen items. His guilty plea from April satisfied all of the burglary charges that GONZALEZ was facing from these incidents.

On April 1, GONZALEZ pleaded guilty to (1) Count of Burglary in the Second Degree, a Class C Violent Felony.

Assistant District Attorney Matthew Hauf of the Major Crimes Unit prosecuted this case.
