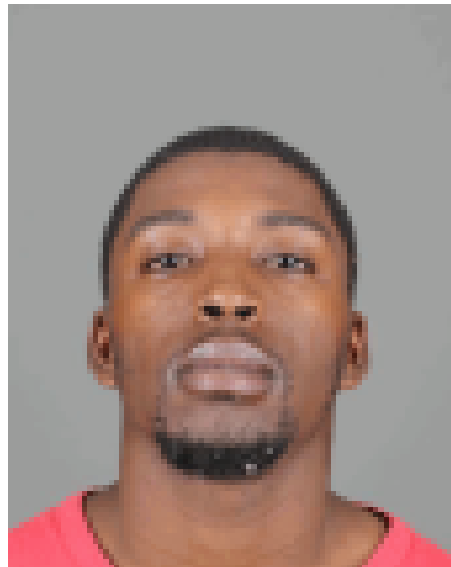

## Sentencing for Violation of Leandra's Law



**ALBANY, NY**- District Attorney P. David Soares announced today that ISSIAH CAIN, 23, of Albany, was sentenced to 4 months in Albany County Jail, to be followed by 5 years of Post Release Supervision, before the Honorable Thomas A. Breslin in Albany County Supreme Court this morning.

On August 10, 2017, CAIN pleaded guilty to one (1) Count of Aggravated Driving While Intoxicated, Child in Vehicle, a Class E Felony.

On June 2, 2017, at approximately 9:05 P.M., CAIN was stopped by New York State Police on I-90, in the City of Albany. CAIN showed physical signs of intoxication and failed all field sobriety tests. CAIN admitted to drinking half a bottle of liquor and was found to have a BAC of .11. This is a Leandra's Law Case as CAIN was driving with a 1-year-old and 2-year-old in the car.

Vehicular Crimes Bureau Chief Mary Tanner-Richter prosecuted this case.
