Sentencing in Albany Drug Case



ALBANY, NY – District Attorney P. David Soares announced today that ALGUN INMAN, 26, of Albany, was sentenced to 7 ½ years in State Prison, to be followed by 3 years of Post-Release Supervision, before the Honorable Peter A. Lynch in Albany County Court this morning.

On September 12, 2016, INMAN pleaded guilty to (1) Count of Attempted Criminal Possession of a Controlled Substance in the Third Degree, a Class C Felony.

On March 5, 2016, at 3:55 AM, on Partridge Street in the City of Albany, members of the Albany Police Department initiated a traffic stop for a vehicle that failed to stop at a red light. During the traffic stop the driver of the vehicle, now known to be INMAN, fled from the car. After being apprehended by police nearby, INMAN was found to be in possession of 24.3

grams of crack cocaine.

Assistant District Attorney Megan Spillane of the Street Crimes Unit prosecuted this case.
