Sentencing in Attempted Robbery



ALBANY, NY - District Attorney P. David Soares announced today that JOHN HUGHES, 35, of Albany, was sentenced to 1 ½ to 3 years in State Prison, before the Honorable Peter A. Lynch in Albany County Court.

On October 26, 2017, HUGHES pleaded to guilty to (1) Count of Attempted Robbery in the Third Degree, a Class E Felony.

On February 20, 2017, at approximately 2:30 PM, in the area of Madison and Eagle Street, in the City of Albany, HUGHES attempted steal property by threatening the victim. Following the threat, HUGHES then attacked the victim knocking off their glasses.

Assistant District Attorney Shanza Malik of the General Crimes Unit is prosecuted this case.
