## Sentencing in Father's Day Homicide

**ALBANY, NY** – District Attorney P. David Soares announced today that **RICHARD DUCKETT**, 20, of Cohoes, was sentenced to 20 years to Life in State Prison, before the Honorable William A. Carter in Albany County Court this morning.

On December 21, 2017, DUCKETT pleaded guilty to (1) Count of Murder in the Second Degree, a Class A-I Felony.

On June 18, 2017, in the area of Delaware Street in the City of Albany, DUCKETT intentionally caused the death of Terrance Roberts, 46, by means of shooting him with an unlicensed firearm, once in his side and once in his head. Prior to the shooting, an altercation had occurred between the victim and DUCKETT'S co-defendants, JASMINE and BRITTANY MINGO, who also aided DUCKETT in fleeing the scene. The firearm was recovered in close proximity to the shooting.

JASMINE and BRITTANY MINGO each previously pleaded guilty to (1) Count of Hindering Prosecution in the First Degree, a Class D Felony and are scheduled to be sentenced on March 23, 2018.

Bureau Chief Jessica Blain-Lewis of the Street Crimes Unit prosecuted this case.
