Sentencings for Two Vehicular Crime Cases

ALBANY, NY – District Attorney P. David Soares announced today the resolutions of two DWI cases in Albany County Court this week.

STEVEN RUSHLOW, 36, of Massena, was sentenced to 2 to 6 Years in State Prison before the Honorable William A. Carter in Albany County Court this morning.

On November 15, 2017, RUSHLOW pleaded guilty to (1) Count of Aggravated Driving While Intoxicated, a Class E Felony under Vince's Law as he was convicted of 3 prior vehicle crimes within the last 15 years. On June 14, 2017, on the 1300 block of Central Avenue, RUSHLOW admitted to being involved in a crash in a parking lot that resulted in property damage. RUSHLOW then fled the scene and was stopped Colonie Police department. RUSHLOW failed all field sobriety tests and registered a BAC of .18.

Additionally, **MARK KING**, 53, of Albany, was sentenced to 1 to 3 Years in State Prison before the Honorable Thomas A. Breslin in Albany County Supreme Court this morning.

On November 15, 2017, KING pleaded guilty to (1) Count of Aggravated Unlicensed Operation of a Motor Vehicle in the First Degree, a Class E Felony. On October 12, 2017, at approximately 1:12 P.M., on Lower Hudson Avenue in the Village of Green Island, KING admitted to operating his vehicle with a license that had a total of 28 suspensions which were accrued on 13 separate dates. At the time of the incident KING was under the supervision of probation stemming from a previous conviction.

Vehicular Crimes Bureau Chief Mary Tanner-Richter prosecuted both cases.
