Sex Offender Pleads Guilty for Failing to Register Address After Moving Out of Skylane Motel



ALBANY, NY – District Attorney P. David Soares announced that **CHRISTOPHER DEYOE**, 28, formerly of Colonie, pleaded guilty to (1) Count of Failure to Register as a Sex Offender, a Class E Felony, before the Honorable Stephen W. Herrick in Albany County Court this morning.

On November 27, 2013, DEYOE, who was serving a term of Federal Probation for a previous sexual offense, absconded from probation by moving from his residence at the Skylane Motel on

Central Avenue in the Town of Colonie, to an address in a neighboring county. The US Marshalls were able to locate and arrest DEYOE on December 12, 2013.

DEYOE faces 1 to 3 years in State Prison when sentenced on July 8, 2014. This time will run concurrently to any federally imposed sentence for probation violation.

Assistant District Attorney Ryan Manley of the Special Victims Unit is handling the prosecution of this case.
