Shawn Dixon Pleads Guilty to DWI



ALBANY, NY – District Attorney P. David Soares announced today that SHAWN DIXON, 31, of Kingston, pleaded guilty to (1) Count of Driving While Intoxicated, a Misdemeanor, today in Albany City Court before visiting Judge Thomas Marcelle.

On December 20, 2017, at approximately 5:00 A.M., members of the Albany Police Department responded to the area of Park Avenue and Eagle Street for a report of a one car motor vehicle crash in which a car stuck a utility transformer. The vehicle was left at the scene unoccupied.

DIXON was located nearby and after an investigation it was determined that DIXON was operating the motor vehicle in an intoxicated state at the time of the crash.

DIXON faces a term of 3 years of Probation when sentenced June 1, 2018. In addition, DIXON will resign from the Albany Police Department at the time of sentencing, and will be required to install and maintain an Interlock Ignition Device for 3 years, pay restitution for the damage to the power transformer, attend a Victim Impact Panel and Impaired Driver Program, be subject to a revocation of his driver's license for a minimum of 6 months, subject to Department of Motor Vehicles, and pay a \$500 fine and mandatory court fees.

Vehicular Crimes Bureau Chief Mary Tanner-Richter prosecuted this case.
