State Prison for Albany Motor Vehicle Theft



ALBANY, NY- District Attorney P. David Soares announced today that **KAHLIL VANDERHORST**, 18, of Albany, was sentenced to 1 1/3 to 3 years in State Prison before the Honorable Peter A. Lynch in Albany County Court this morning.

On September 13, 2013, VANDERHORST pleaded guilty to (1) Count of Criminal Possession of Stolen Property in the Fourth Degree, a Class E Felony.

On July 27, 2013 on Sherman Street in the City of Albany, the defendant was observed by a member of the Albany Police Department operating and in full possession of a stolen Honda Accord. Upon talking with the defendant, the officer discovered him to be in possession of a knife.

This aforementioned state prison sentence will be concurrently served to an additional state prison term of 2 to 6 years after the defendant pleaded guilty to a Violation of Probation, a Class E Felony, before the Honorable Stephen Herrick in Albany County Court.

The violation of probation stems from a previous unrelated conviction of (1) Count of Criminal Possession of a Weapon in the Third Degree, a Class E Felony.

Assistant District Attorney Melinda Seiden of the Vehicular Crimes Unit handled the prosecution of this case.
