Wrong Way Intoxicated Driver Sentenced for St. Patrick's Day Crash on I-90



ALBANY, NY - District Attorney P. David Soares announced today that ANDREW FEBBIE, 21, of Colonie, was sentenced to 3 to 9 years in State Prison, before the Honorable Peter A. Lynch in Albany County Court this morning.

Additionally, FEBBIE will be subject to a minimum of one year license revocation subject to Department of Motor Vehicle determinations, the installation of an Ignition Interlock Device for 3 years upon release from custody, as well as mandatory court fees.

On July 31, 2018, FEBBIE pleaded guilty to (1) Count of Aggravated Vehicular Assault, a Class C Felony, and (1) Count of Aggravated Driving While Intoxicated, a Misdemeanor.

On March 17, 2018, at approximately 5:13 P.M., FEBBIE entered the Everett Road exit on I-90 in the City of Albany going the wrong way and struck another vehicle head-on. As a result of the collision, the driver of the other vehicle suffered multiple fractured bones and internal injuries. At the scene, officers found FEBBIE unconscious, with multiple open containers of alcohol in his vehicle, and an odor of an alcoholic beverage coming from him. Blood taken at the hospital revealed FEBBIE's blood alcohol concentration to be .25 percent; over three times the legal limit. The victim was transported to the hospital and treated for the injuries. At the time of crash, FEBBIE was driving on a conditional license stemming from a previous driving related offense.

Vehicular Crimes Bureau Chief Mary Tanner-Richter and Assistant District Attorney David Szalda handled the prosecution of this case.
