3 Years in State Prison for Residential Stabbing



ALBANY, NY - District Attorney P. David Soares announced today that SHATEEK CAIN, 28, of Albany, was sentenced to 3 years in State Prison, to be followed by 5 years of Post Release Supervision, before Honorable Peter A. Lynch in Albany County Court this morning.

On January 22, 2014, CAIN pleaded guilty to (1) Count of Assault in the Second Degree, a Class D Felony.

On April 16, 2013, while at a residence on Lark Street in the City of Albany, CAIN did intentionally cause physical injury to a victim by stabbing her in the neck and abdomen with a knife. The victim was able to kick the defendant off of her, at which time the defendant fled the scene.

Assistant District Attorney Carmen Warner of the Street Crimes Unit handled the prosecution of this case.
