5 Years in State Prison for Crack Cocaine Sale



ALBANY, NY- District Attorney P. David Soares announced today that LAMONT JOHNSON, 32, of Albany, pleaded guilty to (1) Count of Attempted Criminal Sale of a Controlled Substance in the Third Degree, a Class C Felony, before the Honorable Roger McDonough in the Supreme Court of Albany County this morning.

On December 27, 2012 in the City of Albany, the defendant was observed selling crack cocaine by members of the Albany Police Department.

JOHNSON faces 5 years in State Prison, to be followed by 3 years of Post Release Supervision when sentenced on November 1, 2013.

Assistant District Attorney Kurt Haas of the Street Crimes Unit is handling the prosecution of this case.
