Albany Man Sentenced to 2 to 4 Years in State Prison for Attempted Strangulation



ALBANY, NY- District Attorney P. David Soares announced today that SHAWN MOORE, 40, of Albany, was sentenced to 2 to 4 years in State Prison before the Honorable Roger McDonough in the Supreme Court of Albany County this afternoon.

On October 3, 2013, MOORE pleaded guilty to (1) Count of Attempted Strangulation in the Second Degree, a Class E Violent Felony.

On August 22, 2013 in the City of Albany, MOORE was the passenger in a vehicle driven by the victim when he began striking her in the face and head. MOORE then reached over and put the car into park and continued to strike the victim in the head and face, ultimately strangling her until she lost consciousness.

The defendant then got the victim out of the car and continued to strike her. The incident was observed by officers who were driving by and immediately placed the defendant under arrest.

Assistant District Attorney Carmen Warner of the Street Crimes Unit oversaw the prosecution of this case.
