Bronx Resident Sentenced to 7 Years in State Prison for Selling 50 Bags of Heroin in Albany



ALBANY, NY- District Attorney P. David Soares announced today that CEE CEE COLON, 48, of the Bronx, was sentenced to 7 years in State Prison, to be followed by 3 years of Post Release

Supervision, before the Honorable Thomas Breslin in the Supreme Court of Albany County Court yesterday morning.

On August 15, 2013, COLON pleaded guilty to (1) Count of Attempted Criminal Sale of a Controlled Substance in the Third Degree, a Class B Felony.

On March 8, 2013 in the City of Albany, COLON was observed by members of the Albany Police Department attempting to sell 50 bags of heroin. Subsequent to the sale, a search warrant was executed by members of the Albany County Sherriff's Office in conjunction with the Albany Police Department on a room at the Budget Motel in the Town of Colonie where the defendant was staying

Once inside the motel room, officers located 751 bags of heroin in the defendant's possession.

Assistant District Attorney Sean Childs of the Street Crimes Unit handled the prosecution of this case.
