Damien Zervos Arraigned on Second Degree Murder Charges



ALBANY, NY- District Attorney P. David Soares announced today that DAMIEN ZERVOS, 32, of Albany, was arraigned on (1) Count of Murder in the Second Degree, a Class A-1 Felony, (1) Count of Menacing in the Second Degree, a Class A Misdemeanor and (3) Counts of Endangering the Welfare of a Child, all Class A Misdemeanors.

The indictment alleges that on October 31, 2013 at a residence on Lark Street in the City of Albany, the defendant did intentionally cause the death of Charee Akins-Maddox, 33, of Albany by shooting her with a rifle. At the time of the alleged incident, there were three children under the age of 5 inside the residence.

ZERVOS pleaded not guilty and was remanded in custody without bail.

Special Victims Unit Bureau Chief Shannon Sarfoh is handling the prosecution of this case.
