## Defendant Arraigned after Parole Officer Allegedly Finds Over a Pound of Marijuana During Surprise Visit



**ALBANY, NY-** District Attorney P. David Soares announced today that **QUINTON LACY**, 24, of Cohoes, was arraigned on (1) Count of Criminal Possession of Marihuana in the Second Degree, a Class D Felony, before the Honorable Peter A. Lynch in Albany County Court this morning.

The indictment alleges that on September 14, 2013 on McElwain Avenue in the City of Cohoes, the defendant was in possession of more than sixteen ounces of marijuana that was allegedly discovered by his parole officer on a surprise visit to his residence.

LACY pleaded not guilty and was remanded to the Albany County Correctional Facility without bail.

Assistant District Attorney Carmen Warner of the Street Crimes Unit is handling the prosecution of this case.
