Defendant Pleads Guilty to Burglarizing Albany Apartment



ALBANY, NY- District Attorney P. David Soares announced today that **TIMOTHY PONE**, 28, of Albany, pleaded guilty to (1) Count of Attempted Burglary in the Second Degree, a Class D Violent Felony, before the Honorable Peter A. Lynch in Albany County Court this morning.

On October 12, 2013 on Holland Avenue in the City of Albany, the defendant broke into an apartment and stole electronics and money. The occupant of the apartment came home and confronted the defendant. The victim recognized because he used to live in the same apartment complex until he was recently evicted. The defendant fled by jumping out of the window.

Later in the evening in the area of Delaware Avenue, the victim found the defendant who still had some of the property he stole in his possession. The Albany Police Department was called and he defendant was taken into custody.

PONE faces up to 5 years in State Prison, to be followed by 3 years of Post Release when sentenced on February 6, 2014.

Assistant District Attorney Brian Conley of the Major Offense Unit is handling the prosecution of this case.
