Defendant Pleads Guilty to Menands Burglary



ALBANY, NY- District Attorney P. David Soares announced today that NASHON DOBBS, 23, of Albany, pleaded guilty to (1) Count of Burglary in the Second Degree, a Class C Felony, before the Honorable Thomas A. Breslin in Albany County Supreme Court this morning.

On October 24, 2013 on Sage Hill Lane in the Village of Menands, the defendant unlawfully entered a residence and stole jewelry while inside. Three hours after committing the burglary, the defendant was caught by officers with some of the stolen jewelry in his possession.

DOBBS faces 7 ½ years in State Prison, to be followed by 3 years of Post Release Supervision when sentenced on May 21, 2014. This guilty plea is in full satisfaction of multiple burglaries attributed to this defendant.

Assistant District Attorney Steven Sharp of Legal Affairs Bureau is handling the prosecution of this case.
