Guilty Plea in Madison Avenue Burglary



ALBANY, NY- District Attorney P. David Soares announced today that JOHN MOLONEY, 26, of Albany, pleaded guilty to (1) Count of Attempted Burglary in the Second Degree, a Class D Felony, before the Honorable Peter A. Lynch in Albany County Court this morning.

On September 18, 2011 on Madison Avenue in the City of Albany, MOLONEY broke into an apartment a stole a computer valued at \$2,200.

MOLONEY faces 3 years in State Prison, to be followed by 5 years of Post Release Supervision when sentenced on August 26, 2014 and remains in custody at the Albany County Correctional Facility in lieu of \$50,000 bail to await sentencing. The guilty plea entered by MOLONEY this morning is in full satisfaction of multiple burglaries attributed to him.

Assistant District Attorney Brian Conley of the Major Offense Unit is handling the prosecution of this case.
