John Halacy Pleads Guilty for Role in Colonie Burglary



ALBANY, NY - District Attorney P. David Soares announced today that JOHN HALACY, 24, of Rensselaer, pleaded guilty to (1) Count of Attempted Burglary in the Second Degree, a Class D Violent Felony, before the Honorable Stephen Herrick in Albany County Court this morning.

On November 28, 2013, HALACY, ANDRE BEVERLY, 18, and alleged co-defendant RAYMOND HALACY, 19, unlawfully entered a residence on Haswell Road in the Town of Colonie and stole televisions, computers, video games and guitars while inside. The occupants of the residence were not home at the time of the incident.

Shortly after, HALACY was observed on a closed circuit video camera selling some of the items at a store in Colonie Center.

HALACY faces 5 ½ years in State Prison, to be followed by 3 years of Post Release Supervision when sentenced on April 3, 2014. HALACY will remain remanded in the Albany County Correctional Facility without bail to await sentencing.

On January 17, 2014, ANDRE BEVERLY pleaded guilty to (1) Count of Attempted Burglary in the Second Degree, a Class D Violent Felony, before the Honorable Stephen Herrick in Albany County Court and faces up to 3 years in State Prison when sentenced on March 27, 2014.

The case against RAYMOND HALACY remains open and pending at this time.

Bureau Chief Eric Galarneau of the Major Offense Unit is handling the prosecution of these cases.
