New York State Prison Inmate Sentenced for Pawning Stolen Property



ALBANY, NY- District Attorney P. David Soares announced today that JOHN SUDDARD, 40, formerly of Fort Edward, NY, was sentenced to 3 ½ to 7 years in State Prison as a Predicate Felon before the Honorable Peter A. Lynch in Albany County Court this morning.

On December 18, 2013, SUDDARD pleaded guilty to (1) Count of Criminal Possession of Stolen Property in the Third Degree, a Class D Felony.

The defendant was observed by New York State Police Investigators entering Old Saratoga Coin on Central Avenue in the Town of Colonie with property that Investigators knew was stolen. The defendant received \$3,388 for the stolen items and was arrested when he exited the store.

SUDDARD is currently incarcerated at the Coxsackie Correctional Facility for an unrelated burglary conviction in Washington County, New York.

Assistant District Attorney Linda Griggs of the Major Offense Unit handled the prosecution of this case.
