Predicate Felon Sentenced to 2 ½ to 5 Years in State Prison for Attempting to Steal Televisions from Restaurant



ALBANY, NY- District Attorney P. David Soares announced today that JUNIOR JENNINGS, 18, of Albany, was sentenced to 2 ½ to 5 Years in State Prison as a Predicate Felon before the Honorable Peter A. Lynch in Albany County Court this morning.

On March 20, 2014, JENNINGS pleaded guilty to (1) Count of Burglary in the Third Degree, a Class D Felony.

On March 1, 2014, the defendant broke into DeJohns Restaurant and Pub on Lark Street in the City of Albany by breaking through a window in the back of the building. Once inside, the defendant used a power drill to attempt to steal multiple televisions.

Officers from the Albany Police Department responded to the scene and found the defendant inside the building. After a brief foot chase, the defendant was apprehended.

This case was prosecuted by Assistant District Attorney Steven Sharp of the Legal Affairs Bureau.
