## Second Felony Offender Sentenced to 4 Years in State Prison for Attempted Armed Robbery



**ALBANY, NY-** District Attorney P. David Soares announced today that CHAD FOGARTY, 28, of Watervliet, was sentenced to 4 years in State Prison as a Second Felony Offender, to be followed by 5 years of Post Release Supervision, before the Honorable Peter A. Lynch in Albany County Court this morning.

On August 27, 2013, FOGARTY pleaded guilty to (1) Count of Attempted Robbery in the Second Degree, a Class D Violent Felony.

On January 4, 2013 on Elm Street in the Town of Colonie, the defendant approached a victim who was walking to work and threatened her with a handgun and told her he would kill her if she didn't give him money. The defendant took the victim's purse and fled.

Officers responding to the call found the defendant near a residence on Cohoes Road in the City of Watervliet and gave chase. The defendant was later apprehended after he was identified as the culprit by a witness.

Assistant District Attorney Brian Conley of the Major Offense Unit handled the prosecution of this case.
