## Special Victims Unit Case Resolutions



**ALBANY, NY** – District Attorney P. David Soares announced today that **TERRY NOBLE**, 21, of Delmar, and **JOHN SANDERS**, 19, of Cohoes, have each been sentenced before the Honorable Peter A. Lynch in Albany County Court this morning.

**JOHN SANDERS** was sentenced 1 1/3 to 4 years in State Prison after pleading guilty on April 1, 2013 to (1) Count of Burglary in the Third Degree, a Class D Felony. He was also sentenced to 1 to 3 years in State Prison after pleading guilty to (1) Count of Unlawful Surveillance in the Second Degree, a Class E Felony.

On February 14, 2013 at 4:57am on Ontario Street in the City of Cohoes, SANDERS did break through the window of a convenience store and while inside did steal \$80 in cash and other items.

Forty three minutes later at 5:40am on Ontario Street in the City of Cohoes, SANDERS did unlawfully break through the front door of a convenience store and did steal \$70 in cash and several items while inside.

On October 22, 2012 on Winthrop Street in the Town of Colonie, SANDERS was caught using his cellphone to record a 13 year old girl who is known to him while in the bathroom. After being caught, SANDERS was kicked out of the residence and attempted to regain entry to the residence by kicking the front door, damaging the paneling.

Based on his conviction for Unlawful Surveillance, SANDERS will be required to register as a sexual offender pending a Sexual Offender Registration Act hearing upon his release from State Prison.

Additionally, TERRY NOBLE was sentenced to 10 years of Felony Probation after pleading guilty to (1) Count of Rape in the Third Degree, a Class E Felony, on June 6, 2013. As part of his guilty plea, NOBLE will be required to register as a sexual offender pending a Sexual Offender Registration Act hearing.

Between December 2012 and March 2013, NOBLE did engage in multiple sexual acts with a victim under the age of 16.

Assistant District Attorney Carmen Warner of the Special Victims Unit handled the prosecution of TERRY NOBLE. Assistant District Attorney Warner and Assistant District Attorney Brian Conley of the Major Offense Bureau handled the prosecution of JOHN SANDERS.
