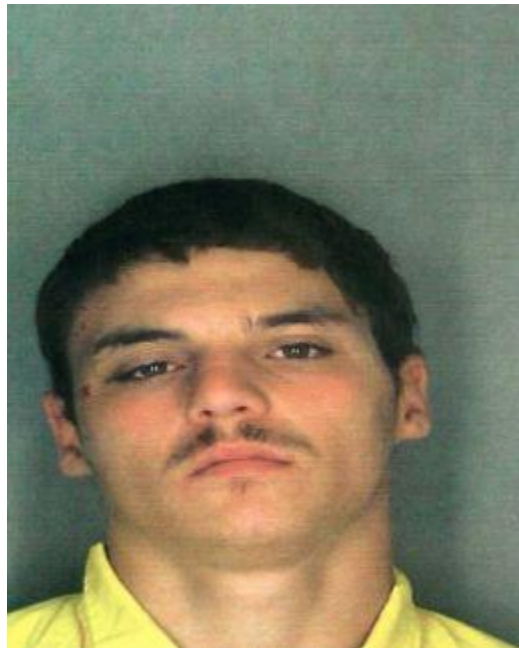

Watervliet Burglar Sentenced to 4 Years in State Prison



ALBANY, NY- District Attorney P. David Soares announced today that ANTHONY PORTER, 21, of Nassau, New York, was sentenced to 4 years in State Prison, to be followed by 5 years of

Post Release Supervision, before the Honorable Peter A. Lynch in Albany County Court this morning.

On August 14, 2013, PORTER pleaded guilty to (1) Count of Burglary in the Second Degree, a Class C Felony.

On June 19, 2013 on Eastview Drive in the City of Watervliet, PORTER, along with an unknown accomplice, did unlawfully enter a residence armed with a handgun. Once inside, the defendant did steal an Xbox game console and other items.

PORTER also must pay restitution to the victim for the stolen property.

Assistant District Attorney Matthew Hauf of the Major Offense Bureau handled the prosecution of this case.
