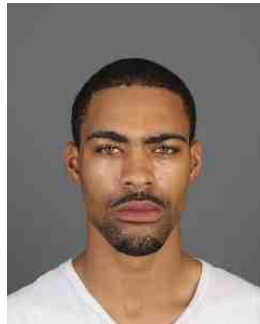

25 Year Sentence for Albany Shooting



ALBANY, NY - District Attorney P. David Soares today announced that JEFFREY WALKER, 24, of Troy, was sentenced to 25 years in State Prison before the Honorable William A. Carter in Albany County Court this morning.

On October 30, 2019, the jury found WALKER guilty of (1) Count of Assault in the First Degree, a Class B Armed Violent Felony, (1) Count of Criminal Use of a Firearm in the First Degree, a Class B Felony, and (1) Count of Criminal Possession of a Weapon in the Second Degree, a Class C Violent Felony.

After hearing evidence and testimony during trial, the jury concluded that on or about October 7, 2018, at approximately 5:40 A.M., near the area of Clinton Avenue and Lark Street in the City of Albany, WALKER intentionally caused serious physical injury to an adult male that was known to him by means of shooting him with an illegally possessed firearm. The victim was struck in the shoulder and survived the incident after receiving medical attention.

Major Crimes Unit Bureau Chief Shannon Corbitt prosecuted this case.
