A Family Affair: Brothers Plead Guilty to Selling Crack Cocaine

ALBANY, NY- District Attorney P. David Soares announced today that MILTON WOOD, 51, of Watervliet, and JAMES WOOD, 52, of Watervliet, each pleaded guilty this morning to criminal drug sales in Albany County Court this morning before Honorable Roger McDonough.

JAMES WOOD pleaded guilty to (1) Count of Criminal Sale of a Controlled Substance in the Third Degree, a Class B Felony.

On June 18, 2013, in a vehicle located on Jackson Avenue in the City of Cohoes, JAMES WOOD did sell a quantity of crack cocaine for \$100. JAMES WOOD faces up to 5 years in

State Prison, to be followed by 3 years of Post-Release Supervision, when sentenced on March 14, 2014.

MILTON WOOD pleaded guilty to (1) Count of Criminal Sale of a Controlled Substance in the Third Degree, a Class B Felony.

On April 17, 2013, in a vehicle on Jackson Avenue in the City of Cohoes, MILTON WOOD did sell a quantity of crack cocaine for \$100. MILTON WOOD faces up to 12 years in State Prison, to be followed by 3 years of Post-Release Supervision, when sentenced on March 14, 2014. As part of the plea WOOD also forfeited a 2003 Mercedes Benz that was used during the drug transaction.

The transactions were captured on police surveillance video.

New York State Police subsequently executed a search warrant at the apartment of MILTON WOOD on First Avenue in Watervliet, and recovered a quantity of marijuana, a quantity of heroin, a digital scale, 3 boxes of sandwich baggies, a quantity of small ziplock bags, and over \$1750.00 in US currency. Police also recovered a quantity of crack cocaine from WOOD's vehicle.

The pleas today satisfy additional drug sales attributed to these defendants.

Assistant District Attorney Jasper Mills of the Street Crimes Unit handled the prosecution of this case.
