Albany Burglar Faces Up To 7 Years In State Prison



ALBANY, NY- District Attorney P. David Soares announced today that KAYAAN MARROW, 24, of Albany, pleaded guilty to (2) Counts of Attempted Burglary in the Second Degree, both Class D Violent Felonies, before the Honorable Stephen Herrick in Albany County Supreme Court this morning.

On June 18, 2012, MARROW burglarized a home in the City of Albany and stole a laptop and jewelry. On June 25, 2012, MARROW, along with Co-Defendant BRANDON JIMENEZ, 20, burglarized a home in the City of Albany. As they were entering the home, a police officer responded to the scene, and both MARROW and JIMENEZ fled. MARROW was apprehended a few blocks away, and JIMENEZ was later arrested on June 29, 2012.

MARROW faces up to 7 years in State Prison when sentenced on December 19, 2012. On September 27, 2012, JIMENEZ pleaded guilty to (2) Counts of Attempted Burglary in the Second Degree, both Class D Violent Felonies. JIMENEZ faces up to 7 years in State Prison when sentenced on November 15, 2012.

Assistant District Attorney Steven Sharp of the Legal Affairs Bureau prosecuted this case.
