Albany Store Robber Sentenced



ALBANY, NY – District Attorney P. David Soares today announced that KENDRICK BELLAMY, 36, of Albany, was sentenced to a total of 8 years in State Prison, to be followed by 5 years of Post- Release Supervision, before the Honorable William A. Carter in Albany County Court this morning.

On November 5, 2017, at approximately 11:07 PM, in the area of 26 North Third Street, in the City of Albany, BELLAMY and an unapprehended individual, while wearing masks and plastic gloves, walked into a convenience store and forcibly stole property while displaying a pistol. During the incident, BELLAMY struck the store clerk in the head with the pistol while the other participant stole money from the register. After fleeing the scene, BELLAMY was

found hiding nearby in an industrial facility behind the convenience store wearing the exact clothing depicted in the robbery, including sneakers with distinct purple backs. The loaded gun and plastic gloves were also found near BELLAMY'S vicinity. The entire incident was captured on video surveillance.

On April 5, 2018, BELLAMY pleaded guilty to (1) Count of Attempted Robbery in the First Degree, a Class C Armed Violent Felony.

Assistant District Attorney Joseph Brucato of the Major Offense Unit handled the prosecution of this case.
