Armed Bank Robber Pleads Guilty



ALBANY, NY - District Attorney P. David Soares announced today that RODOLFO RIOS, 52, of Feura Bush, pleaded guilty to (1) Count of Attempted Robbery in the First Degree, a Class C Felony, before Honorable Judge Roger McDonough in Albany County Supreme Court this morning.

On December 18, 2013, at approximately 11:30 a.m., officers from the Albany Police Department responded to the M&T Bank, located at 80 State Street, for a report of a robbery.

The report stated that a male suspect had entered the bank armed with a knife and demanded money from a teller. The teller complied and the suspect fled the scene with an undisclosed

amount of cash.

Shortly after the incident, an Albany Police Officer saw a person matching the robber's description and apprehended RIOS. RIOS was found in possession of the money, a knife, and a plastic baggie containing crack cocaine.

RIOS faces 13 years in State Prison when sentenced on February 20, 2015.

This is not RIOS's first conviction for bank robbery.

In 2006 RIOS was convicted for the armed robbery of the Citizens Bank located at 10 North Pearl Street in Albany. RIOS was sentenced to 9 ½ years in state prison for that incident and was released to the supervision of New York State Parole on October 9, 2013.

Assistant District Attorney Linda Griggs is prosecuting this case.
