Arraignment in Alleged Attempted Murder Case

ALBANY, NY – District Attorney P. David Soares announced today that NATHAN HENNESY, 21 of Albany, was arraigned before the Honorable William A. Carter in Albany County Court this morning.

HENNESSY, along with alleged co-defendant KYLE CROSS, 21, of Albany, was indicted by a Grand Jury on (1) Count of Attempted Murder in the Second Degree, a Class B Armed Violent Felony, (1) Count of Criminal Use of a Firearm in the First Degree, a Class B Armed Violent

Felony, (1) Count of Robbery in the First Degree, a Class B Armed Violent Felony, (1) Count of Attempted Assault in the First Degree a Class C Armed Violent Felony, (1) Count of Assault in the Second Degree, a Class D Violent Felony, and (1) Count of Criminal Possession of a Weapon in the Second Degree, a Class C Armed Violent Felony.

The indictment alleges that on November 29, 2017, in the area of Old Hickory Drive, in the City of Albany, HENNESSY and CROSS allegedly attempted to cause the death of another person by shooting the victim and forcibly stealing his property. The victim survived his injuries after treatment at an area hospital.

HENNESSY pleaded not guilty to the charges and was remanded without bail. CROSS was previously arraigned before Judge Peter A. Lynch on Monday December 18, 2017 and has been remanded without bail. No new appearance dates have been scheduled at this time for either defendants.

Assistant District Attorney Brittany Grome of the Major Offense Bureau is handling the prosecution of this case.
