Arraignment in Alleged Attempted Murder Case



ALBANY, NY – District Attorney P. David Soares announced today that JORDAN PRUSINSKI, 26, of Albany, was arraigned before the Honorable Judge Roger D. McDonough in Albany County Supreme Court this afternoon.

PRUSINSKI was previously indicted by a Grand Jury on (1) Count of Attempted Murder in the First Degree, a Class A-1 Felony, and (1) Count of Attempted Murder in the Second Degree, a Class B Violent Felony.

The indictment alleges that on July 2, 2017, on the 300 block of Hamilton Street, in the City of Albany, PRUSINSKI allegedly attempted to cause the death of two males by allegedly firing 11 shots, hitting one victim once and the other twice.

PRUSINSKI pleaded not guilty to the charges and was remanded into custody pending the posting of bail. No new appearance dates have been scheduled at this time.

General Felony Unit Bureau Chief Steven Sharp is handling the prosecution of this case.
