Arraignment in Alleged Elk Street Murder



ALBANY, NY – District Attorney P. David Soares today announced that STEPHAN HARRIS, 22, of Albany, was arraigned before the Honorable Roger D. McDonough in Albany County Supreme Court this morning.

HARRIS was previously indicted by an Albany County Grand Jury on a charge of (1) Count of Murder in the Second Degree, a Class A-1 Felony.

The indictment alleges that on May 20, 2017, at approximately 1:00 A.M., on Elk Street in the City of Albany, HARRIS did allegedly cause the death of another person who was known to him by stabbing the victim in the stomach following an alleged verbal altercation.

HARRIS pleaded not guilty to the charge today and was remanded into custody pending a bail hearing. No new court appearance dates have been scheduled at this time.

Major Offense Unit Bureau Chief Shannon Corbitt and Assistant District Attorney Brittany Grome are handling the prosecution of this case.
