Attempted Murder Shooter Sentenced to 22 Years to Life



ALBANY, NY – District Attorney P. David Soares announced today that JORDAN PRUSINSKI, 26, of Colonie, was sentenced to 22 years to Life in State Prison before the Honorable Roger D. McDonough in Albany County Court this morning.

On April 28, 2018, PRUSINSKI was found guilty after a jury trial of (1) Count of Attempted Murder in the First Degree, a Class A Felony, and (1) Count of Attempted Murder in the Second Degree, a Class B Felony.

On July 2, 2017, while near the corner of Lark and Hamilton Streets in the City of Albany, PRUSINSKI fired 11 shots from a loaded weapon at four people who were unknown to him. Two victims were shot during the incident and survived after medical treatment.

General Felony Unit Bureau Chief Steven Sharp prosecuted this case.
