Brian Scavo Found Guilty of Harassment



ALBANY, NY – District Attorney P. David Soares announced today that BRIAN SCAVO, 62, of Albany, was found guilty after a bench trial of (1) Count of Harassment in the Second Degree: Following a Person in or About a Public Place, and (1) Count of Harassment in the Second Degree: Engaging in a Course of Conduct which Alarm or Seriously Annoy Another Person, both Violations, before the Honorable Richard Sherwood in Guilderland Town Court this morning.

On December 19, 2015, at approximately 9:45 P.M. while at Crossgates Mall in the Town of Guilderland, SCAVO did annoy and harass a female victim by following her and repeatedly asking for her personal information. SCAVO had previously harassed this victim at Crossgates Mall on several different occasions in late 2015.

SCAVO was immediately sentenced after the verdict to pay fines and surcharges to the Court and a No Contact Order of Protection was issued in favor of the victim.

Assistant District Attorney Collin D'Arcy prosecuted this case at trial.
