## **Brothers Sentenced To Prison For Menands Robbery**

**ALBANY, NY-** District Attorney P. David Soares announced today that brothers KIESHAWN CHANEY, 20, of Albany, and ZACHARIHAS CHANEY, 21, of Albany were sentenced to 7 years in State Prison to be followed by 3 years of Post Release Supervision and 10 Years in State Prison to be followed by 5 years of Post Release Supervision, before the Honorable Roger D. McDonough in Albany County Supreme Court this morning.

On June 23, 2017 KIESHAWN CHANEY pleaded guilty to (1) Count of Attempted Robbery in the Second Degree, a Class C Armed Violent Felony. On the same day, ZACHARIHAS CHANEY pleaded guilty to (1) Count of Robbery in the Second Degree, a Class C Felony.

On March 27, 2017, at approximately 8:20 PM, in the area of Pateman Circle and North Sage Hill Lane, in the Village of Menands, CHANEY and CHANEY, along with two other individuals (R.Cooper and M.Green), did forcibly steal personal property and during the course of the crime, caused physical injury to the victim. CHANEY and CHANEY, aided by two others, did punch the victim's head multiple times, and while another participant displayed what appeared to be a firearm, did steal the victim's cellphone and wallet. Using GPS, Officers did track the victim's phone and wallet to be located in a vehicle, with CHANEY and CHANEY and the two other defendants.

On November 16, 2017, MESSIAH GREEN was found guilty by jury trial of (2) Counts of Robbery in the Second Degree, a Class C Violent Felony, (1) Count of Robbery in the Second Degree, a Class C Armed Violent Felony, (1) Count of Assault in the Second Degree, a Class D Violent Felony, (1) Count of Grand Larceny in the Fourth Degree, a Class E Felony, and (4) Counts of Criminal Possession of Stolen Property in the Fourth Degree, a Class E Felony. On August 4, 2017, RAYMEEN COOPER pleaded guilty to Robbery in the Second Degree.

Assistant District Attorney Dennis DiBari of the Major Offense Unit prosecuted this case.
