

Cab Stabbing Results in Guilty Verdict



ALBANY, NY - District Attorney P. David Soares announced today that NICHOLAS SIGNOR, 22, of Rhinebeck, NY, was found guilty after a bench trial of (1) Count of Assault in the Second Degree, a Class D Felony, before the Honorable William A. Carter in Albany County Court.

On September 10, 2016, at approximately 2:00 A.M., while in the vicinity of Washington Park, in the City of Albany, SIGNOR did stab an adult male while in a cab twice in his upper right arm and once in his right forearm with a knife. SIGNOR attempted to flee the cab without paying when the victim attempted to stop him. SIGNOR disposed of the bloody weapon in the park. When he was apprehended, SIGNOR was observed having blood on his hands and attempted to lie about his identity. The victim sustained wounds to his arm and received 50 stitches to repair his exposed muscle tendons.

SIGNOR faces up to 7 years in State Prison when sentenced on November 28, 2017.

Assistant District Attorney Dennis DiBari of the Major Offense Bureau prosecuted this case.
