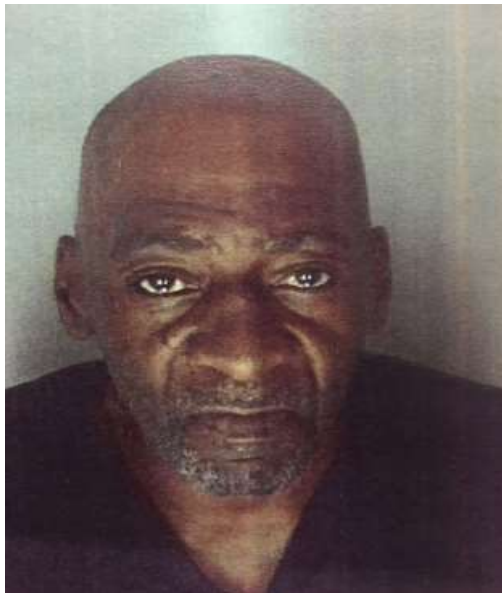

Clothing Store Burglar Pleads Guilty Before Trial Begins



ALBANY, NY - District Attorney P. David Soares announced today that BRYANT YARBROUGH, 56, of Albany, pleaded guilty to (1) Count of Burglary in the Third Degree, a Class D Felony, before the Honorable Roger D. McDonough in Albany County Supreme Court this morning.

On January 23, 2016, at approximately 1:50 A.M., on Central Avenue in the City of Albany, YARBROUGH unlawfully entered the One Stop Clothing Store by throwing a chunk of brick through the front door window. Once inside YARBROUGH stole a large amount of clothes and personal care products.

The trial against YARBROUGH was slated to begin today in Albany County Court, but YARBROUGH pleaded guilty before jury selection began.

YARBROUGH faces up to 4 years in State Prison when sentenced on May 19, 2017.

Assistant District Attorney Joseph Brucato of the Major Offense Unit prosecuted this case.
