## Co-Defendants in Father's Day Homicide Sentenced

**ALBANY, NY-** District Attorney P. David Soares announced today that JASMINE MINGO, 35, and BRITTANY MINGO, 27, both of Cohoes, were each sentenced for their role in a homicide case, before the Honorable William A. Carter this morning.

JASMINE MINGO was sentenced to an indeterminate sentence of 1 1/3 to 4 years in State Prison and BRITTANY MINGO was sentenced to 6 months in Albany County Jail, to be followed by 5 years of Felony Probation.

On January 26, 2018, JASMINE and BRITTANY MINGO each pleaded guilty to (1) Count of Hindering Prosecution in the First Degree, a Class D Felony.

On June 18, 2017, in the area of Delaware Street in the City of Albany, an altercation was started by JASMINE MINGO at a Father's Day barbeque, which led to RICHARD DUCKETT, 20, to arrive at the scene. DUCKETT then intentionally caused the death of Terrance Roberts, 46, by means of shooting him with an unlicensed firearm, once in his side and once in his head. JASMINE and BRITTANY MINGO aided DUCKETT in fleeing the scene. The firearm was recovered in close proximity to the shooting. On February 1, 2018, DUCKETT was sentenced to 20 years to Life in State Prison, before the Honorable William A. Carter in Albany County Court.

Bureau Chief Jessica Blain-Lewis of the Street Crimes Unit prosecuted this case.
