Con Man Kindlon Sentenced 7 ½ to 15 Years In State Prison



ALBANY, NY – District Attorney P. David Soares announced today that FRANK KINDLON, 69, of Delmar, was sentenced to 7 ½ to 15 years in State Prison before the Honorable Thomas Breslin in Albany Supreme Court this morning. KINDLON previously pleaded guilty to (1) Count of Grand Larceny in the Second Degree, a Class C Felony.

Between April 2009 and March 2011, KINDLON stole over \$200,000 from the victim. Kindlon, exploiting a relationship with the victim, made false representations that he was administering to a legal matter involving a mutual acquaintance. Cash payments were made to Kindlon, for what the victim believed to be various surcharges, taxes, security and courier fees, for a fictitious court case. KINDLON convinced the victim that under a Judge’s order, the victim needed to comply with the law and was required to provide these cash payments.

The victim reached out to law enforcement for assistance. The New York State Police conducted an investigation which included the recording of meetings between KINDLON and the victim, leading to his subsequent arrest.

KINDLON was previously convicted of several counts of Grand Larceny in 1993 and sentenced to 10 years in State Prison.

“Through his deception and lies, Mr. Kindlon took from his victim not only money, but also a sense of trust. Those in our community who commit these types of crimes can expect to be prosecuted swiftly and severely,” commented DA Soares.

Deputy Chief Assistant District Attorney Cheryl Fowler handled the prosecution of this case.
