Drug Trafficker Pleads Guilty



ALBANY, NY - District Attorney P. David Soares announced today that EFRAIN ACEVEDO III, 26, of Colonie, pleaded guilty (1) Count of Criminal Sale of a Controlled Substance, in the Second Degree an A-II felony before the Honorable William A. Carter in Albany County Court.

On June 30, 2015, at 1:00 P.M., in the area of Hastings Drive, in the Town of Colonie, County of Albany, ACEVEDO knowingly and unlawfully sold crack that weighed ½ an ounce or more to another person.

On August 17, 2016, ACEVEDO was sentenced to 3 years of Post Release Supervision on a previous narcotics case and was released on his own recognizance pending an appeal. Following his appeal, ACEVEDO was re-arrested and found guilty in this case.

ACEVEDO faces 9 1/2 years in State Prison when sentenced on December 8, 2017 and will also be required to pay restitution to the DEA.

Assistant District Attorney Megan Spillane of the Street Crimes Unit prosecuted this case.
