## **Drunk Car Thief Pleads Guilty**



**ALBANY, NY** - District Attorney P. David Soares announced today that TERRY L. BROWN, 49, of Schenectady, pleaded guilty to (1) Count of Driving While Intoxicated, a Class E Felony, and (1) Count of Criminal Possession of Stolen Property in the Fourth Degree, a Class E Felony, before the Honorable Stephen W. Herrick in Albany County Court yesterday morning.

On September 11, 2014, at approximately 9:04pm, BROWN was driving in a stolen vehicle when he approached the Exit 25 Thruway Toll Booth in the Town of Guilderland. BROWN then struck a vehicle and was advised by a Toll Booth collector to pull over to the side of the road. BROWN then turned around and headed to Thruway Exit 26. BROWN was then observed by a Toll Booth collector pulling the vehicle onto the shoulder and walking into the woods near

Thruway Exit 26. State Police later found BROWN unable to stand without assistance and he failed field sobriety tests.

BROWN faces up 1 to 3 years in State Prison for the Driving While Intoxicated count, and up to 1 1/2 years in State Prison for the Possession of Stolen Property count, when sentenced on December 11, 2014.

Vehicular Crimes Unit Assistant District Attorney Stephanie Richter is prosecuting this case.
