Fugitive Gets Sentenced



ALBANY, NY – District Attorney P. David Soares announced today that DAVIS STEWART, 29, of Albany, was sentenced to 6 years in State Prison, to be followed by 5 years of Post Release Supervision, before the Honorable Judge Thomas A. Breslin in Albany County Supreme Court this morning.

On June 5, 2017, STEWART pleaded guilty to (1) Count of Attempted Criminal Possession of a Weapon in the Second Degree, a Class D Armed Violent Felony.

On May 15, 2017, in the area of Orange Street, in the City of Albany, the Albany Police Department responded to a “shots fired” call in the area. Officers recovered a loaded firearm in

STEWART's possession after an investigation. STEWART confessed to the Officers that the loaded firearm did belong to him. STEWART was then taken into custody.

Assistant District Attorney Brittany Grome of the Major Offense Unit prosecuted this case.
