Grandfather Found Guilty after Trial



ALBANY, NY - District Attorney P. David Soares announced today that RICHARD BAGLEY, 44, of Albany, was found guilty after jury trial of (1) Count of Attempted Assault in the Second Degree, a Class E Felony, before the Honorable Judge Peter A. Lynch in Albany County Court Friday afternoon.

On April 29, 2013, at about 10:00pm, while in the area of Madison Avenue in the City of Albany, BAGLEY did attempt to cause physical injury to his 3 year old grandson by means of kicking him in the torso, causing the child to fly back 3 to 4 feet on to the concrete. A passerby witnessed the assault and called Albany Police.

BAGLEY faces up to 1 1/3 to 4 years in State Prison when sentenced on November 7, 2014.

Assistant District Attorney Ryan Manley of the Special Victims Unit prosecuted this case.
