Guilty Plea In Crack Cocaine Sale



ALBANY, NY – District Attorney P. David Soares announced today that **TREVON JOHNSON**, 36, of Albany, pleaded guilty to (1) Count of Attempted Criminal Sale of a Controlled Substance

in the Third Degree, a Class C felony before Judge Dan Lamont in Albany County Court this morning.

On July 3, 2012, JOHNSON was observed by police selling crack cocaine. When police moved in to arrest JOHNSON, JOHNSON fled in his car but crashed into a police vehicle in the process. JOHNSON then fled on foot but was apprehended shortly after.

JOHNSON faces 5 Years in State Prison followed by 3 Years of Post Release Supervision as well as restitution for the damaged police vehicle when sentenced on January 9, 2013.

Assistant District Attorney Kurt Haas of the Street Crimes Unit prosecuted this case.
