Guilty Plea for Cocaine Sale



ALBANY, NY- District Attorney P. David Soares announced today ROBERT “SWEET PEA” JOHNSON, 22, of Albany, pleaded guilty to (1) Count of Criminal Sale of a Controlled Substance in the Third Degree, a Class B Felony, before the Honorable Judge Peter A. Lynch in Albany County Court this morning.

On August 20, 2014, around 6:57 p.m., at the northeast corner of Grand Street and Madison Avenue, in the City of Albany, JOHNSON did knowing and unlawfully sell crack cocaine, a narcotic drug, to another person for a sum of United States currency.

JOHNSON was previously convicted of a drug crime after he pleaded guilty to (1) Count of Criminal Sale of a Controlled Substance in the Fifth Degree, a Class D Felony, on June 16, 2011.

JOHNSON faces 4 1/2 years determinate in State Prison and 3 years of Post Release Supervision when sentenced on July 29, 2015.

Assistant District Attorney Jasper Mills of the Street Crimes Unit is prosecuting this case.
